Our motto is **“ALL THAT I AM I OWE; I LIVE ETERNALLY IN THE RED”**.

About the Athletes to First Responder Charitable Fund, Inc. Program

Across the United States, chapters like the Firefighters Institute for Racial Equality Retirees have created 501C3 organizations to support their causes. We have collaborated with professional athletes, educators, and other community leaders that sustain healthy, productive relationships with our youth. Those local programs have produced successes in recruiting firefighters, strengthening community relationships, and raising money to recruit black firefighter candidates. Our program will build on what we have learned by those individual efforts. Our team of selected members of the Athletes to First Responder Charitable Fund, Inc. work with local fire departments to generate interest in the fire service where we target area high schools, colleges, and boys/girls’ clubs, etc. The leadership team will set up and create training sessions targeting these organizations across the city recruiting underserved youth 14 – 18 years of age. Fire service leaders will conduct a program to train participants on all the various disciplines in the fire service and emergency medical services such as Paramedics, Emergency Medical Technician (EMT), Emergency Medical Dispatcher (EMD) for interested participants.
